On Level

Next week students will find whole-number quotients and remainders with up to four-digit dividends and one-digit divisors, using strategies based on place value, the properties of operations, and/or the relationship between multiplication and division. Students will illustrate and explain the calculation by using equations, rectangular arrays, and/or area models. Our unit 2 math assessment will be given on October 30.

Accelerated

Next week students will read and write decimals to thousandths using base-ten numerals, number names, and expanded form. An example of expanded form is $347.392 = 3 \times 100 + 4 \times 10 + 7 \times 1 + 3 \times (1/10) + 9 \times (1/100) + 2 \times (1/1000)$. Our unit 2 math assessment will be on October 30.
